



A Saturday walk in Hackney

2.5km plus a bus ride, from Hoxton overground station to Homerton overground station

Recommended by Garden Co-Ordinator Anne Greig

This walk connects three of Hackney's community gardens, showcasing different kinds of local involvement and a residential square.

From Hoxton Overground Station, head south to Cremer Street, then turn right to cross Kingsland Road onto Falkirk Street. At the end of the street turn right onto Hoxton Street. A five-minute walk, passing Hoxton Hall on your right, brings you to **The Hoxton Trust** community garden (**Saturday and Sunday 10am-6pm**) on Tyssen Street.

After your visit return to Hoxton Street and turn right onto Stanway Street. Continue as far as Hare Walk on your left, which takes you to Kingsland Road. Turn left and cross the road into Pearson Street, which leads you to **St Mary's Secret Garden (Saturday 10am-7pm)**.

From the corner of Pearson and Appleby Streets, walk south on Appleby Street to Dunloe Street. Turn left along Dunloe Street to Queensbridge Road. Cross the road and walk north through Haggerston Park, with its City farm and community orchard, to reach Whiston Road. Cester Road is a cul-de-sac on the north side of Whiston Road, and it leads to **Gloucester Square Gardens (Saturday 10.30am-6pm)**.

Return to Whiston Road, and from bus stop WA take the 394 bus towards Homerton Hospital. Alight at the hospital and head round the corner to Wardle Steet to find **Core Landscapes Community Gardens (Saturday 12-5pm)**.

Afterwards, retrace your steps down Wardle Street and cross Homerton High Street to Homerton Overground station (a five-minute walk).
